This part amendment to Ordinance has come into effect from 13/8/2011 the day on which it has been approved by the Chancellor of Goa University under Statute SA-2 (6) as amended. The part amendment to Ordinance is approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 3rd May, 2011 and by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 19th May, 2011.

Part amendment to Ordinance OA-17 relating to minimum attendance for eligibility to appear for Examinations conducted by Goa University.

Ordinance OA-17 relating to Minimum attendance for eligibility to appear for Examinations conducted by Goa University.

OA-17.3 (viii) A student representing the Institution/University/State/Country in extra curricular activities such as NCC/NSS/Sports/Cultural events on obtaining prior approval of the Principal/Dean/Head of Department shall be treated as 'on duty' at the lectures/practicals missed by him/her and shall be marked as 'D' in the Attendance Register. Absence due to such activities should be supported by documentary evidence issued by appropriate authority such as Commanding Officer of NCC., Director of Youth Affairs, Director/Asstt. Director of Sports in Government/University or and authorized official of these and other similar bodies. However, in such cases, for the purpose of compilation of cumulative as well as paper/course-wise attendance, the number of prescribed lectures/practicals for the paper/course shall be calculated after deducting the lectures under 'D' and considered as such e.g. $[(\text{No. of lectures attended}) \div (\text{No. of prescribed lectures}) - \text{Ds}] \times 100$ similarly for practicals.

(xi) For Courses in the field of Medicine / Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy/Engineering which are governed by the regulations of Central governing bodies such as MCI, DCI, AICTE, CCIM, etc. the norms prescribed by the respective bodies shall be followed with regard to the minimum attendance requirements.
